

GENERAL RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All competitions are run under British Dressage Group Rules, this includes tack, turn out, etc.,
2. Entries close two weeks prior to competition.
3. **All Entries will be on a first come first serve basis up to the close of entries and must be accompanied with a S.A.E.. If the class is oversubscribed your entry will be returned.**
4. **Times of riding to be obtained by telephoning 01603 721443 between approximately 7.00pm and 8:30pm on the Friday prior to competition.**
5. All changes/substitutes must be notified to the Secretary, and are allowed at the Secretary's discretion.
6. For all classes the Secretary may refuse an entry from anyone who it is felt is either under or over horsed.
7. All horses to be four years old or over.
8. The judges decision is final.
9. All persons coming onto show premises do so at their own risk.
10. The organisers reserve the right to amend the schedules as they see fit.
11. **Honesty code : see rules 12 / 13 / 14**
12. Horses entering both league classes will only be eligible for one level through out the series please make clear on entry form.
13. To ensure as far as possible fair and equal competition, riders must have regard as to whether they and their horse are entered at the correct level for their experience/track record
14. Riders may not ride more than 2 horses per class.
15. Previous league winning combinations are not eligible for this years league but may compete in classes.
16. On entering you accept the club conditions & rules.

All entered combinations will be eligible for the dressage leagues for Class 2 and Class 4.

Class 5 Has now become a **Pick Your Own** test & will be placed on %.

At the last competition, the overall points winner for each of classes 2 and 4 (riding the same horse) in each league, will be awarded a lesson voucher with either Paul or Tessa and a Fielder Horse and Rider perpetual challenge trophy.

Points awarded based on place in class.
